



2019 Photo Contest FAQs

Can I submit my entry form and photos electronically (via e-mail)?

Yes. Digital images must be submitted via email (.zip file) or on a disk (CD or DVD). The entry form may be completed on-line and included as a PDF, or may be printed, signed and mailed with the disk and/or printed images.

Can I submit all my digital images on a single disk?

Yes. In fact, the rules state that you must submit all digital entries on a single disk, and the disk must contain only the images you are submitting for the contest.

I don't live in the Heritage Area. Can I still enter the contest?

Yes, please! If you took a ride on the Tributary Trails, visited a gallery, went to a festival, or visited any of the 14 heritage area communities and you took some great photographs while you were there, we'd be delighted if you entered them in the contest. But please, make sure the image depicts a location **WITHIN** the Heritage Area.

I can't download the entry form. How can I enter the contest?

When and how will winners be announced?

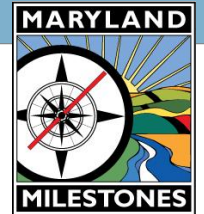
Judging takes place within two weeks of the contest's deadline and the list of winners will be posted on www.marylandmilestones.org and/or issued in a press release in early October.

The winning images are featured in the annual Anacostia Trails Heritage Area calendar and on www.marylandmilestones.org. All images are kept by Anacostia Trails Heritage Area Inc. and may be used on the website or in printed materials produced in the future with credit given to the photographer.

2019 Calendar FAQs

When will the calendars be ready?

The calendars are printed and sent to various distribution sites throughout the Heritage Area in December. A complete list of sites is posted on www.marylandmilestones.org and issued in a press release at that time.

How can I get a calendar?

By stopping by one of our distribution sites throughout the Area. A complete list of sites is posted on www.marylandmilestones.org and issued in a press release by the beginning of December.

Can I have more than one?

Because we can only print a limited quantity, we request that you take only one copy per household. We would love to be able to print more, but our resources are limited.

How did you determine where to distribute the calendars?

First, by location. All sites must be located within one of the 17 municipalities that make up the Heritage Area. Second, by accessibility. Since the calendar comes out in December when many museums and visitor centers in the Area have limited hours, we have worked with specific locations and sites to ensure a broad access location.

Why doesn't my local site have any calendars, even though my local paper said it would?

Although we try to distribute the calendars equitably, we simply can't afford to send copies to every community, visitor center, and museum within the Heritage Area. We recommend that you check the list on our website, www.marylandmilestones.org and call the distribution site before making the trip.

I moved away from the area, but learned about the calendar on your website. Is there any way I can get a calendar?
